XVIII Seminar on Harmonization of Registration and Control of Veterinary Medicines Americas Committee on Veterinary Medicines (CAMEVET)

Sao Paulo, Federative Republic of Brazil
October 3 – 5, 2012

As a result of the proposals and conclusions of previous Seminars, the situation of countries regarding the implementation of the harmonized documents on the Committee shall be reviewed, as well as the participation in global standards, through the chapters for Veterinary Products in the Terrestrial and Aquatic Animal Health Codes of the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE).

The seminar will include the review of the linking actions between CAMEVET with OIE and other organizations and regional and global projects, such as the participation in the VICH Outreach Forum.

Various technical topics shall be presented, including the continuity in the working papers raised in previous seminars, on the following topics:

- Requirements for registration of homeopathic and herbal products
- Guideline for the registration of biotechnologically obtained subunit immunogens
- Stability in veterinary medicinal products
- Agreement on use of synonyms in Spanish.
- Good distribution practices for Veterinary Products
- Control of Infectious bovine rhinotracheitis (IBR) vaccines

New topics will be presented:

- Guidelines for the establishment of withdrawal periods of Veterinary Products.
- Updated the method for the determination of maximum residue limits used by JECFA.

Finally, the Seminar will provide the opportunity for the presentation and discussion of the CAMEVET Strategic Plan, which will define the objectives and goals for the Committee in the coming years.

The vaccine should be applied in advance at least 10 days before departure. Certificates are valid for 10 years.
