






Art. 23 - Animal transport by road should be carried out in a vehicle suitable for the species being transported, in compliance with the animal welfare principles and loading densities recommended in Annex 01 of this Instruction, available on the MAPA website, on the Internet.


Art. 21. The EPE must be located in a place with easy access to the transport and be in relation to the place of embarkation, 8 (eight) hours of travel by road animal transport [...].

Art. 24. The journey time of the animals, comprised between the embarkation of the animals in the EPE and its disembarkation in the egress point of the destiny country, must respect, in any situation, the maximum limit of 12 (twelve) hours of deprivation of access to the water and food, and take into account the following factors:

I - the state of health of the animals, their general welfare and their physical condition for travel.

Art. 26. The maritime or fluvial transportation must be previously planned by the transporter and the exporter, carried out in ships approved by the Captaincy of the Ports that have qualification for the transportation of animals, with trained drivers for the transportation of live cargo, conducted in such a way as to prevent animal damage and minimize travel stress, while respecting animal welfare standards and loading densities recommended in Annex 01 to this Instruction.

Art. 26 - Sole paragraph - Vessels must be sufficiently supplied with food, drinking water and medication for the trip, appropriate to the animal species transported.

CHAPTER VIII - AIR TRANSPORT OF ANIMALS

Art. 35. The veterinarian in charge of the export operation shall be responsible for providing direct and immediate veterinary assistance to the animals kept in the establishment (...), as well as to notify the competent health authority of any suspicion of disease or when is found a situation involving a risk to the animal welfare or to the objectives of the EPE.







Article 37. The exporter together with the veterinarian in charge of the EPE are responsible for the general health of the animals and their physical fitness for travel, regardless of whether third parties are hired to perform certain services during handling and transport.

Art. 36 - Animals must be inspected by a veterinarian of the Official Veterinary Service (SVO) designated by the DSA / SDA or SFA / UF at the opening and closing of the isolation period to verify compliance with the health requirements established by importing countries.

Supervise, at MAPA's discretion, the arrival of the animals to the egress point, observing the general conditions of the animals and the transporting trucks, such as structure, vehicle sealing, cargo density, hygiene and sanitary documentation.






Upon completion of boarding, the official international transit documents are issued: International Animal Health Certificate - CZI.
