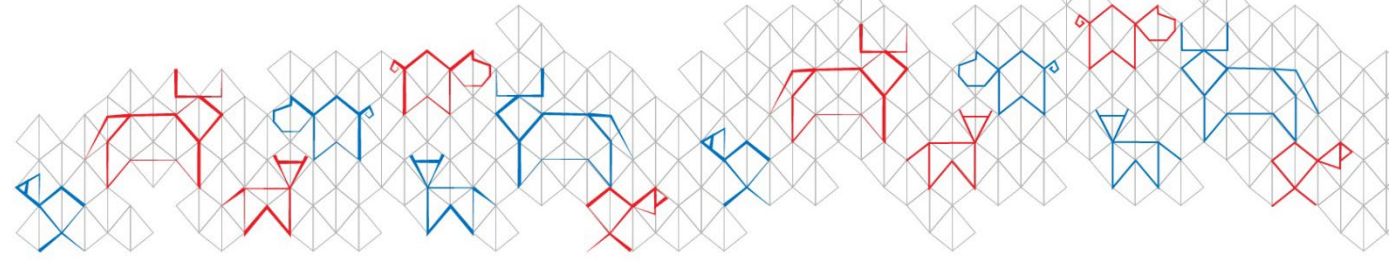




Main donors (ASF activities)

Activities by partners (ASF Project)

- **FAO**

Coordination of activities of the Project on ASF, lead of GF-TADs field missions (Haiti and Dominican Republic), liaison with Haitian Veterinary authority, online ASF online training, regional risk assessment.

- **FAO/USAID-BHA/USDA-APHIS**

Risk Assessment, awareness, early detection, Systemic biosecurity, standard operational procedures, livelihood protection with focus on Haiti, Dominican Republic and Americas region

- **IICA**

Regional capacity building (Webinars) on ASF topics (for veterinarians and pig producers)

- **OIRSA**

Capacity building in Central America (preparedness, laboratory diagnostic, simulation exercises, risk analysis) and Dominican Republic (field operations, surveillance)

- **Subregional organizations (CAN, CVP, CAHFSA, CaribVet, OIRSA)**

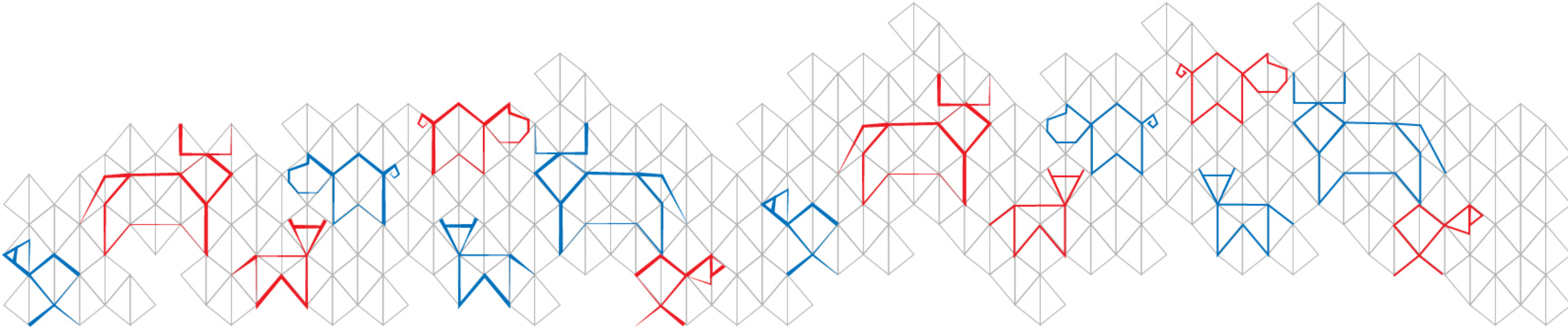
