

## Objective

To anticipate, reduce and manage the risk of contagion events between wildlife, livestock and humans at the human-environment-animal interface.

In order that WOAH Members:

• Improve the risk management for pathogen emergence in wildlife and their transmission to the H-A-E interface.

 Enhance their surveillance, early detection and disease reporting systems with good animal health and welfare practices in trade management.





• Promote the Regional Wildlife NFP Network, to favour scientific exchange and better understand the regional reality (reducing the turnover rate of NFPs).

- Articulation between institutions (Agriculture, Environment and Health) with a view to interministerial agreements and arrangements.
- Encourage the creation of PPPs through inter-sectoral meetings, agreements and funding arrangements.

Evaluation of legislation at national level through technical review groups and consultancies
to promote political will and government support.

Communication plan for the dissemination of WOAH Standards, guidelines and manuals.



• Risk Analysis - disease-based approach: Coordination with sub-regional and regional organisations for technical capacity building and access to information.

 Analysis of wildlife health and related environmental factors in the PVS pathway (WOAH HQ consultation for reference).

• Define the scope of epidemiological surveillance in wet markets according to needed/available resources.
