



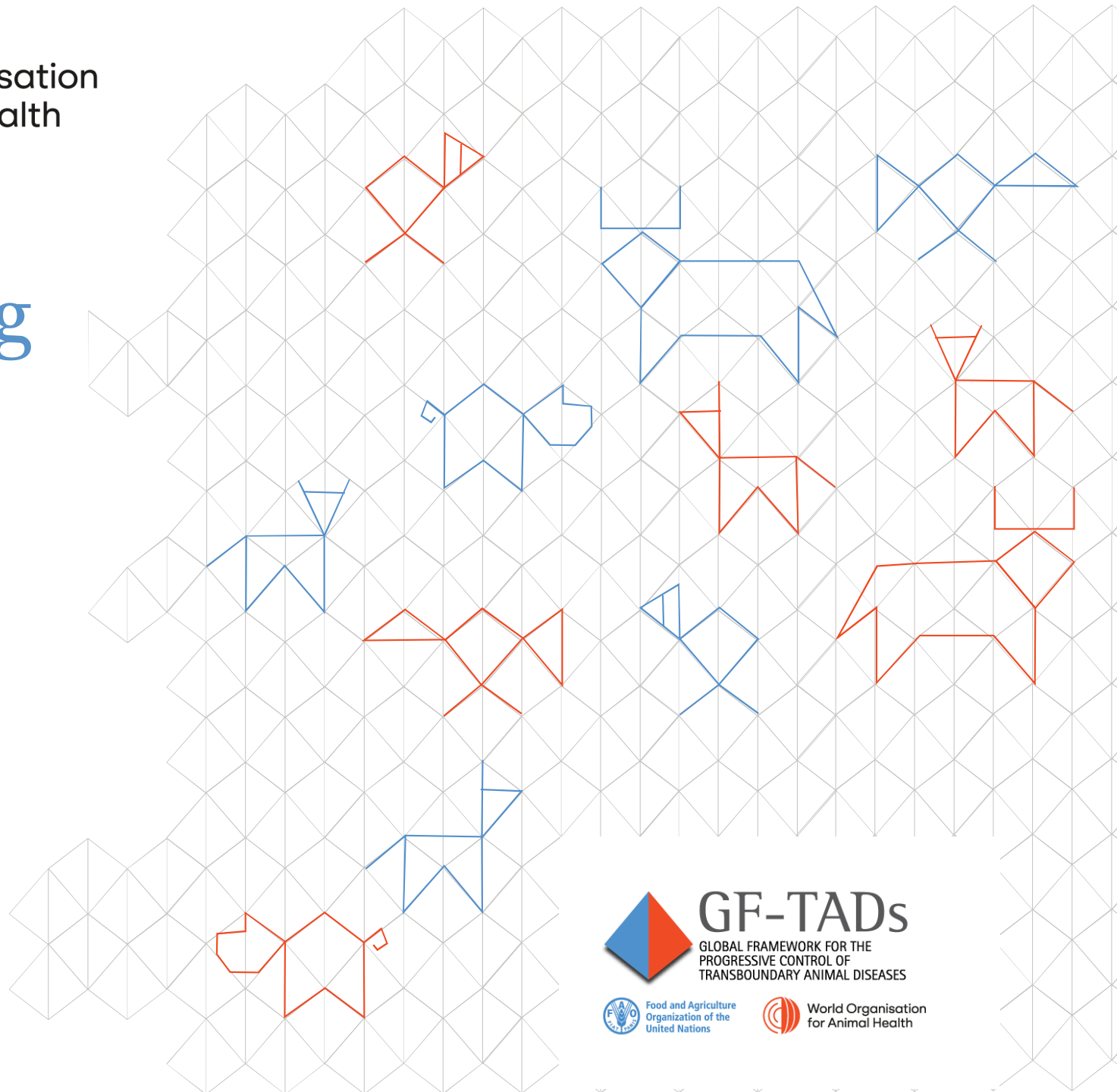

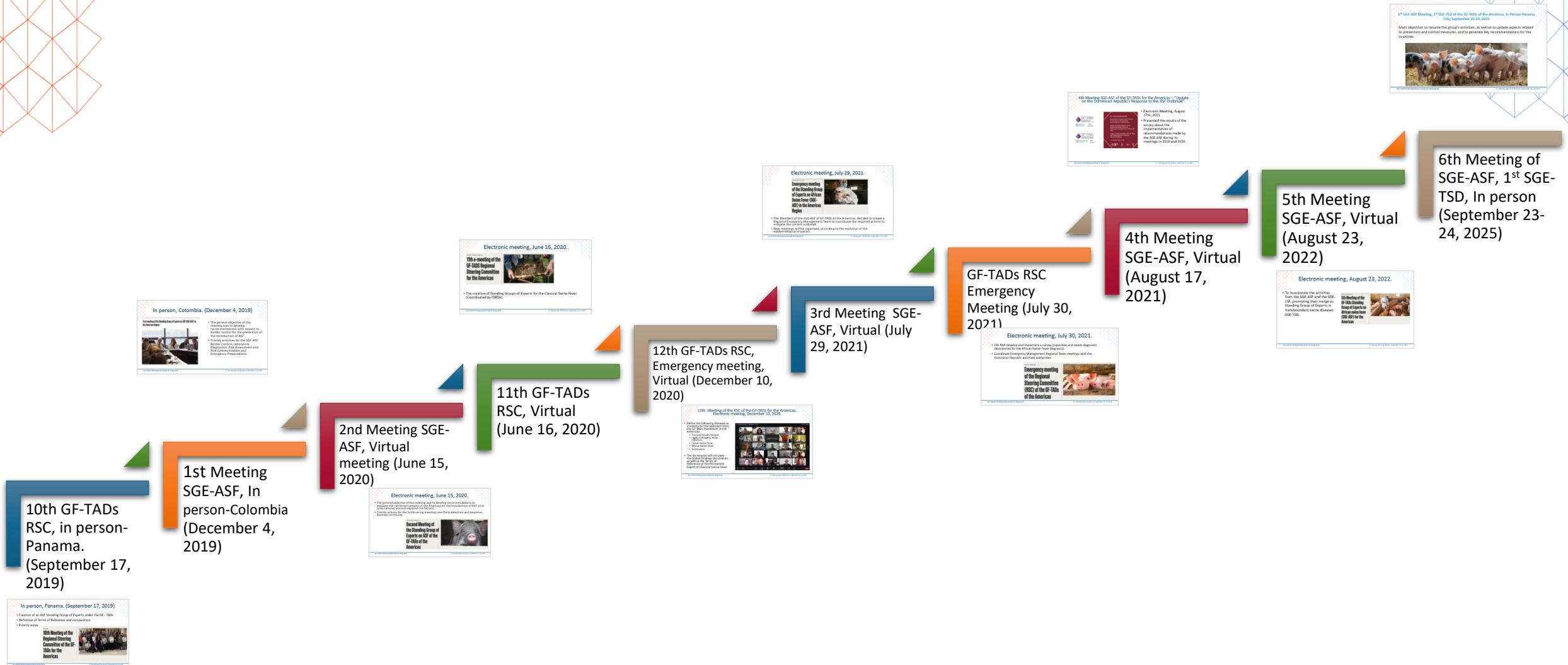

10th Meeting of the Regional Steering Committee of the GF- TADs for the Americas



In person, Colombia. (December 4, 2019)

First meeting of the Standing Group of Experts on ASF (SGE-ASF) in the Americas Region



- The general objective of the meeting was to develop recommendations with respect to border control for the prevention of the introduction of ASF
- Priority activities for the SGE-ASF: Border Control, Laboratory Diagnostics, Risk Assessment and Risk Communication and Emergency Preparedness

Electronic meeting, June 15, 2020.

- The general objective of the meeting was to develop recommendations to evaluate the risk factors present in the Americas for the introduction of ASF virus (also national and sub-regional risk factors).
- Priority actions for the forthcoming meetings are: Early detection and response, Business continuity.

- Define the following diseases as a priority for the approach from the GF-TADs framework in the Americas:
 - Foot and Mouth Disease,
 - Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza,
 - Classic Swine Fever,
 - African Swine Fever
 - Screwworm
- The Secretariat will circulate the Global Strategy documents, as well as the Terms of Reference of the Permanent Expert of Classical Swine Fever.

AFRICAN SWINE FEVER ALERT

Emergency meeting of the Standing Group of Experts on African Swine Fever (SGE- ASF) in the Americas Region



- The Members of the SGE-ASF of GF-TADs of the Americas, decided to create a Regional Emergency Management Team to coordinate the required actions to mitigate the current outbreak.
- New meetings will be organized, according to the evolution in the epidemiological situation.

Electronic meeting, July 30, 2021.

- OIE RRA develop and implement a survey (capacities and needs diagnostic laboratories for the African Swine Fever diagnosis).
- Coordinate Emergency Management Regional Team meetings with the Dominican Republic and Haiti authorities.

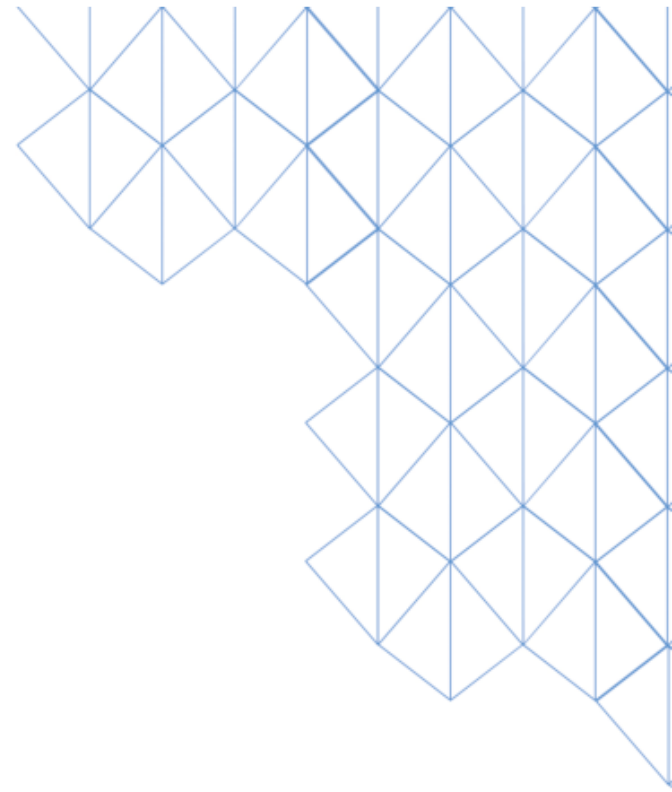
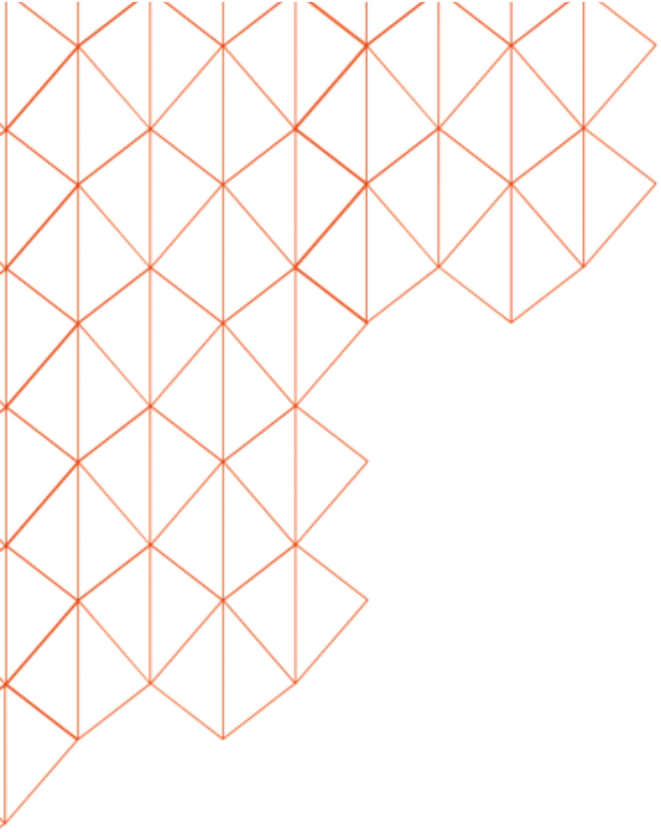
