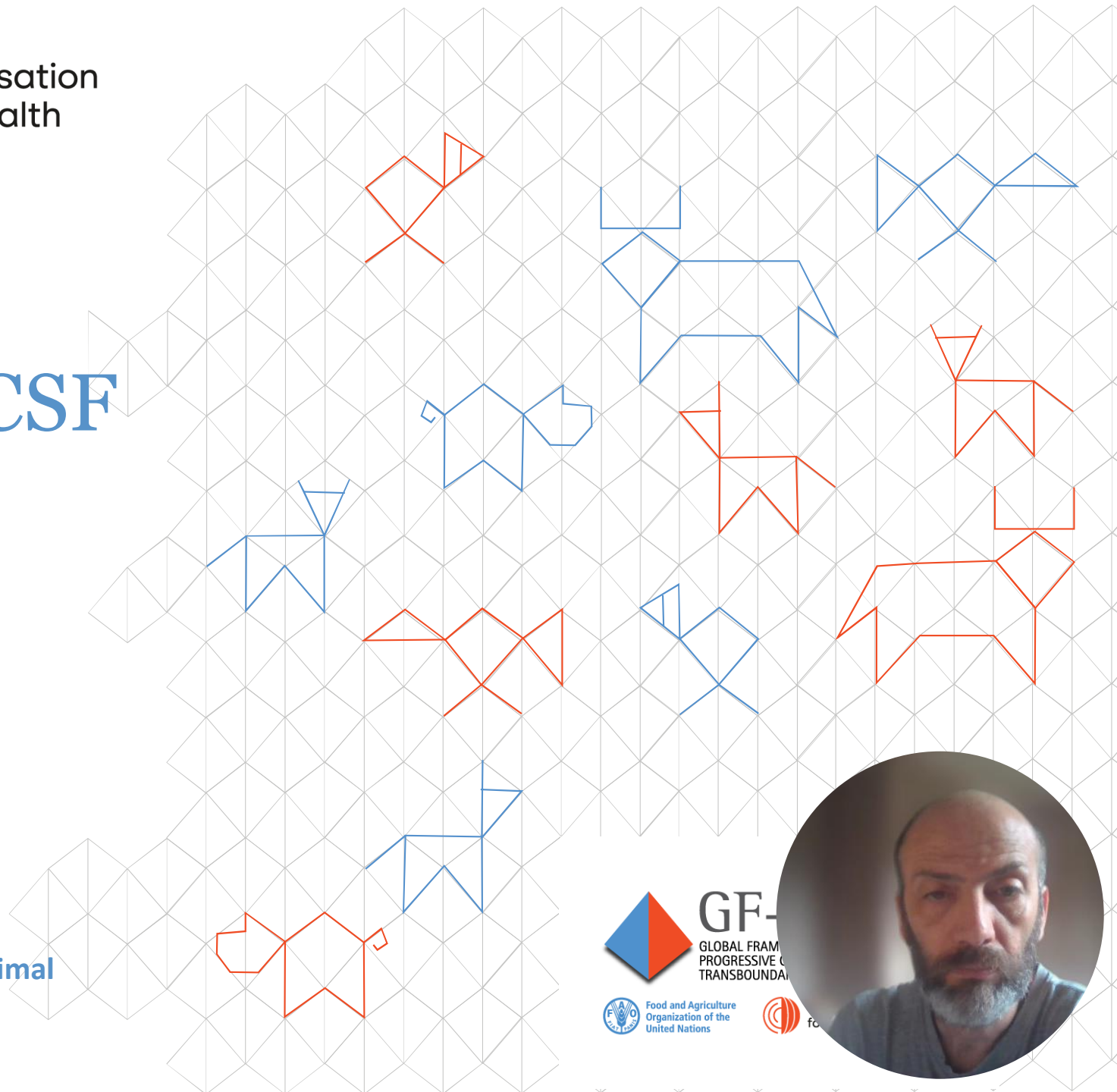

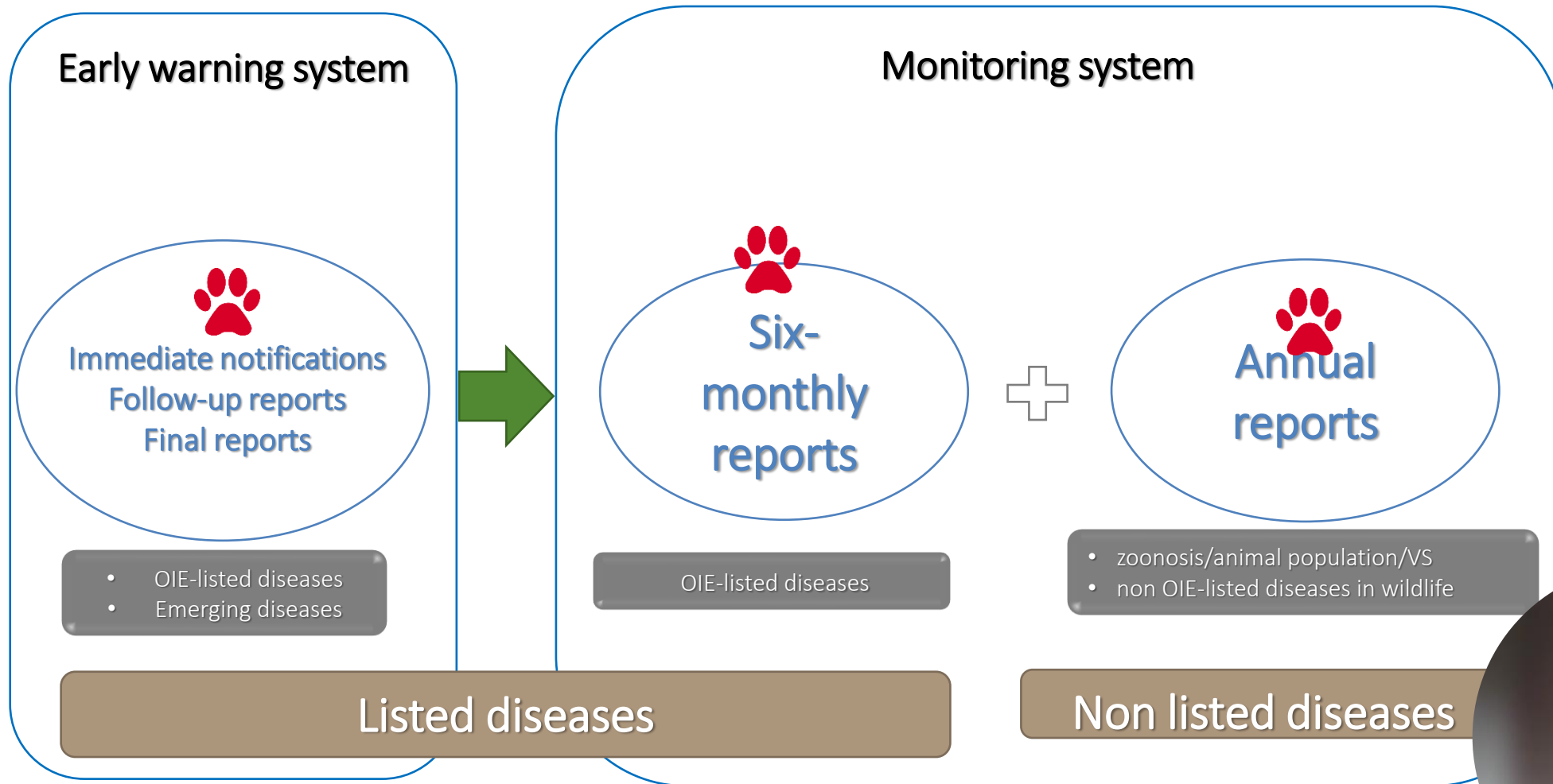

WOAH mission and reporting obligation – Reporting channel



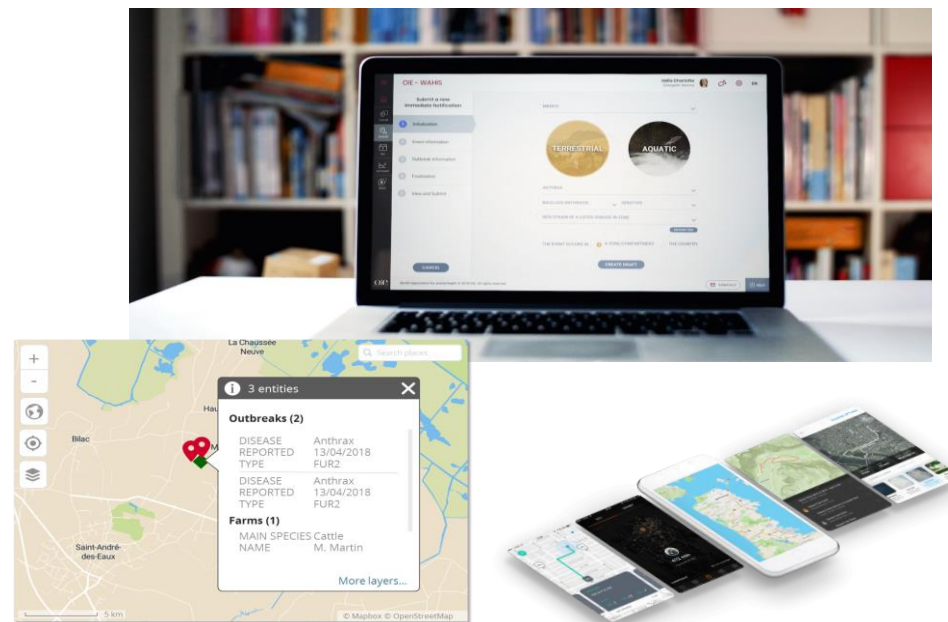
WOAH mission and reporting obligation – Case definition (ASF example)

- Case definition to report an ASF case to the WOA – Chapter 15.1 *TAHC*
 - For the purposes of the [Terrestrial Code](#), African swine fever (ASF) is defined as an [infection](#) of **suids** with ASFV.
 - The following defines the occurrence of [infection](#) with ASFV:
 1. ASFV has been **isolated from samples from a suid**;
 - **OR**
 - 2. **antigen or nucleic acid specific to ASFV** has been identified in samples from a **suid showing clinical signs or pathological lesions suggestive of ASF** or **epidemiologically linked** to a suspected or confirmed [case](#) of ASF, or from a suid giving cause for suspicion of previous association or contact with ASFV;
- **OR**
- 3. **antibodies specific to ASFV** have been detected in samples from a **suid showing clinical signs or pathological lesions consistent with ASF**, or **epidemiologically linked** to a suspected or confirmed [case](#) of ASF, or for suspicion of previous association or contact with ASFV.

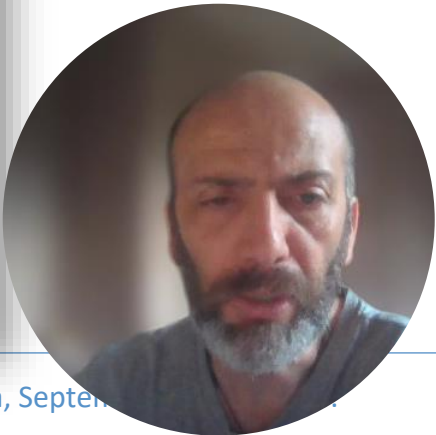

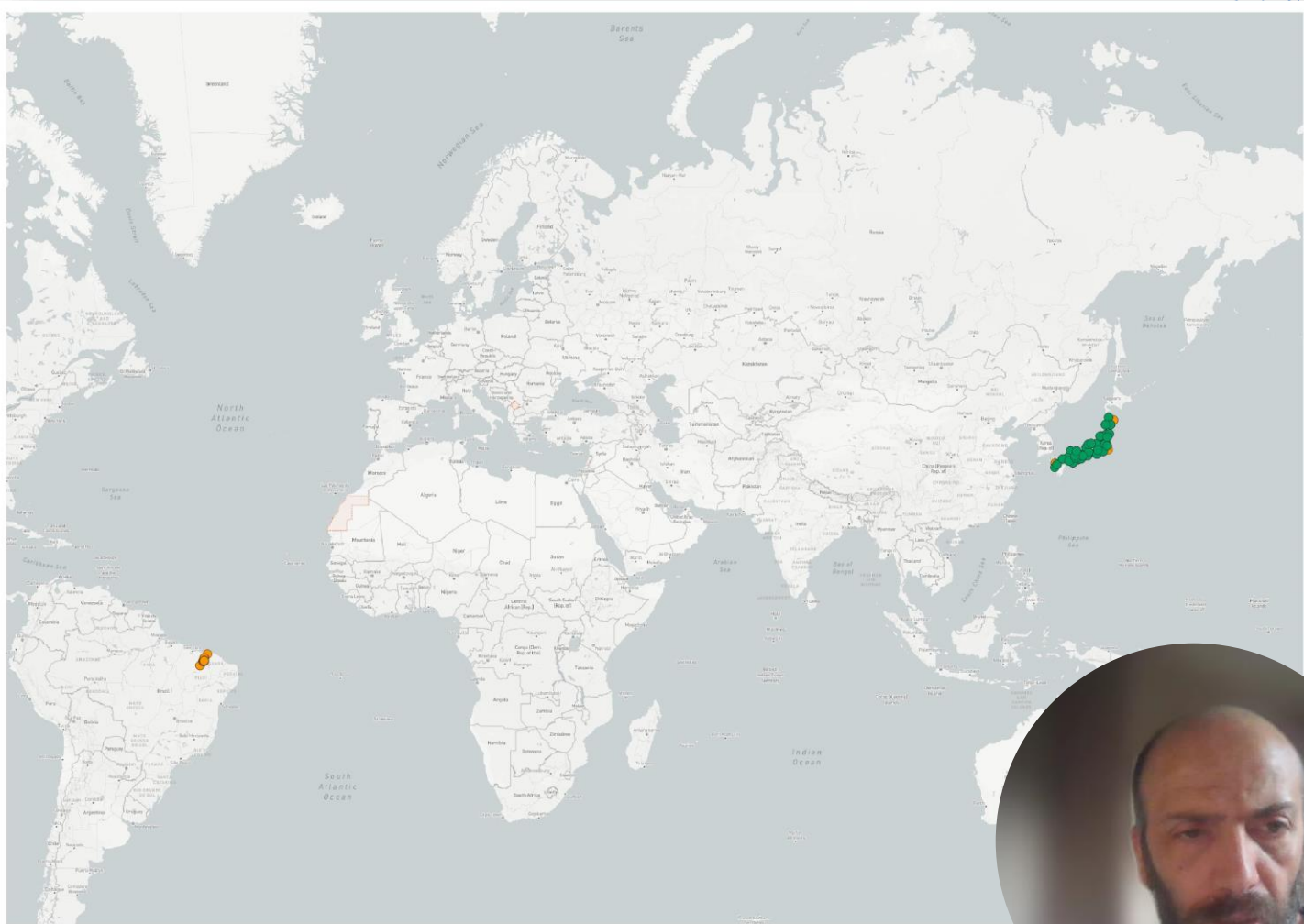

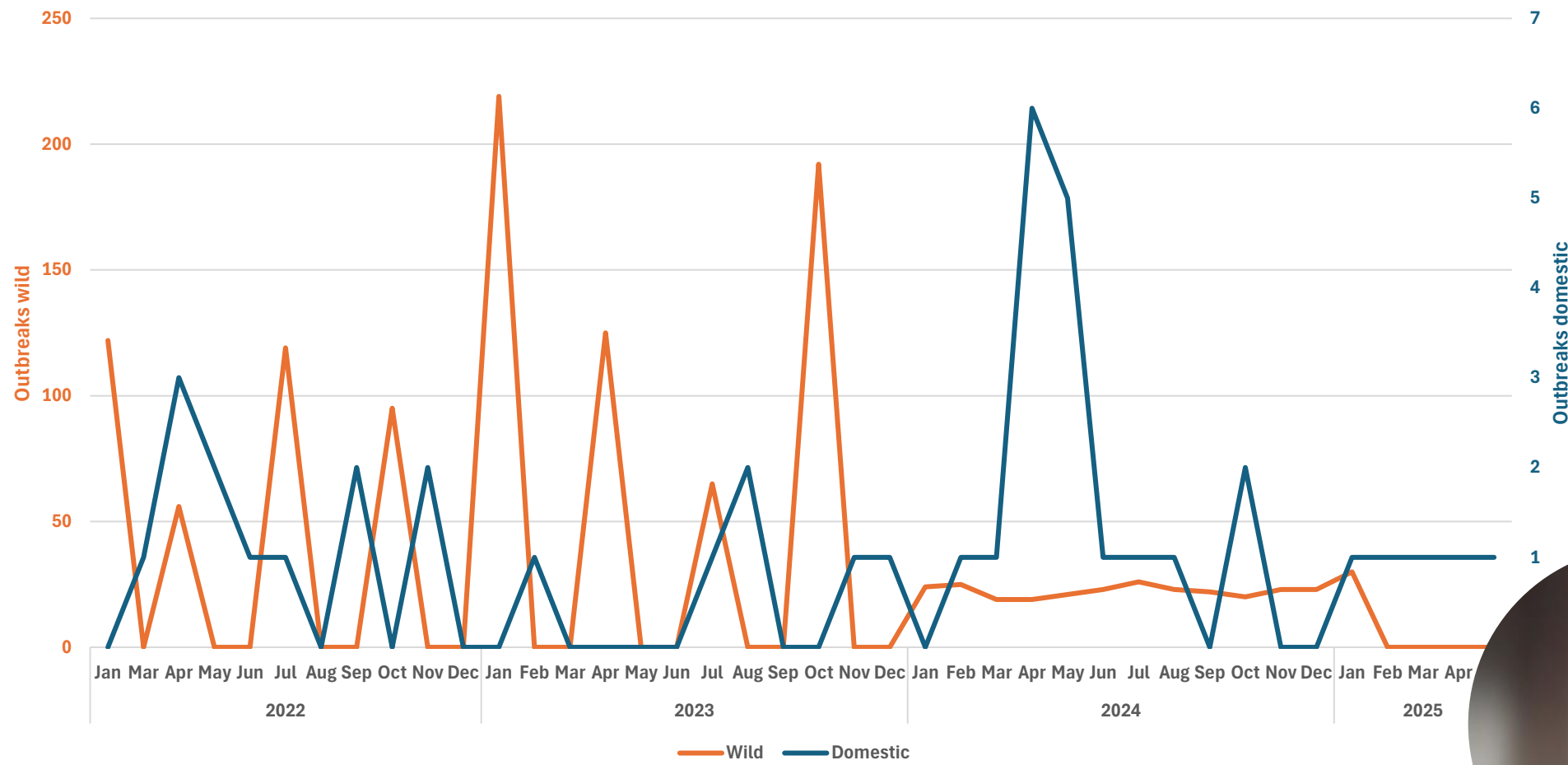

AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) Situation Report 68

Period covered: August 2025

This report provides an update of the ASF situation, according to the information shared with WOAH.

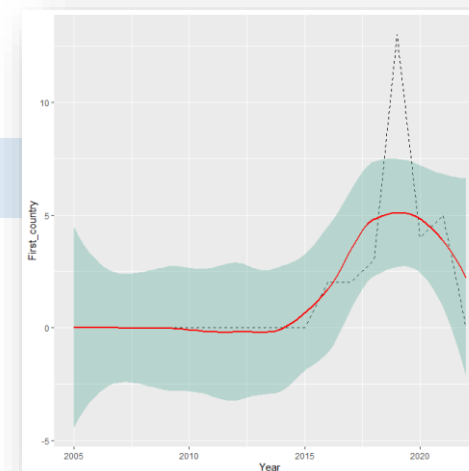
Key highlights

- During the period covered by this report, **one** country in Europe reported one new ASF event, while **eleven** countries in Europe updated their ongoing events. No new outbreak was reported by countries/territories in Africa, Asia, the Americas and Oceania. **One-hundred and thirty-seven** new outbreaks were reported in domestic pigs and **229** in wild boars in Europe, with **2,086** animal losses in domestic pigs.
- About **61%** of the outbreaks were reported in areas with a pig density of more than 10 pigs per square kilometre.
- Since February 2025, the number of outbreaks reported in domestic pigs and wildlife through immediate notifications and follow-up reports via the [World Animal Health Information System \(WAHIS\)](#) has shown a decreasing trend.
- In June 2025, **44** outbreaks were reported more than 10 km outside previously affected areas. In particular, in Estonia, it has been observed an ASF "jump" of around 37 km from the nearest reported ASF outbreaks. This reaffirms the necessity of maintaining high biosecurity standards and surveillance to limit the disease spread.
- Since January 2022, **12** countries have reported ASF as a first occurrence in the country and 10 countries have reported its spread to new zones.
- Since January 2022, **1,046,020** cases in pigs and **38,453** cases in wild boars have been reported, with **2,193,906** animal losses in domestic pigs.
- Since January 2022, **68** countries and territories have reported the presence of ASF.

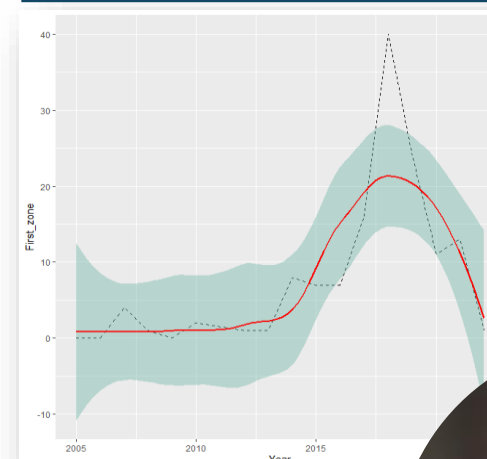


Summary and key messages

- Importance of providing information through official reporting through WAHIS
- ASF epidemiological situation
 - Global presence
 - Mostly reported through early warning system (2022 – 2025)
 - 304 new events reported through Immediate notification
 - 12 countries and territories reported the first occurrence in the country
 - 12 countries and territories reported the first occurrence in a zone
 - 31 countries and territories reported the recurrence of the disease



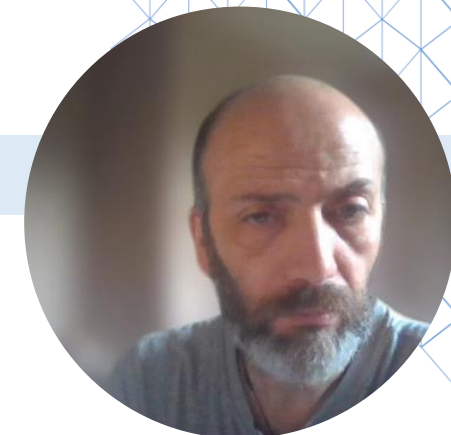
**First occurrence country

- Importance of providing information through official reporting through WAHIS
- CSF epidemiological situation:
 - *Distribution mostly in the Americas and Asia*
 - *Mostly reported as stable situation through monitoring system*
 - *Events reported through early warning system:*
 - *3 events for the recurrence of the disease*
 - *2 countries*
