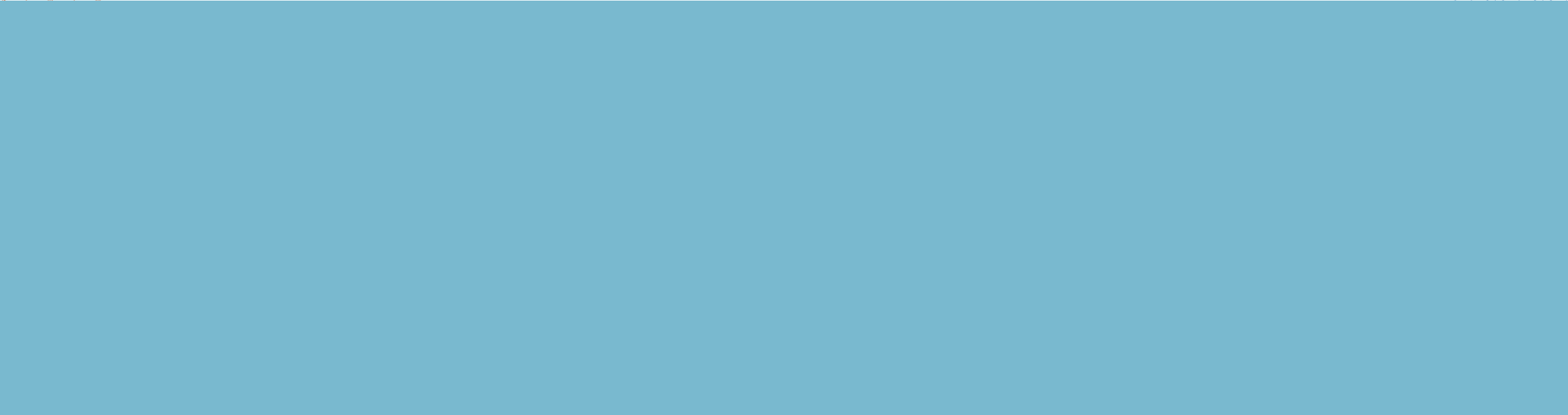

Geographic distribution of actions

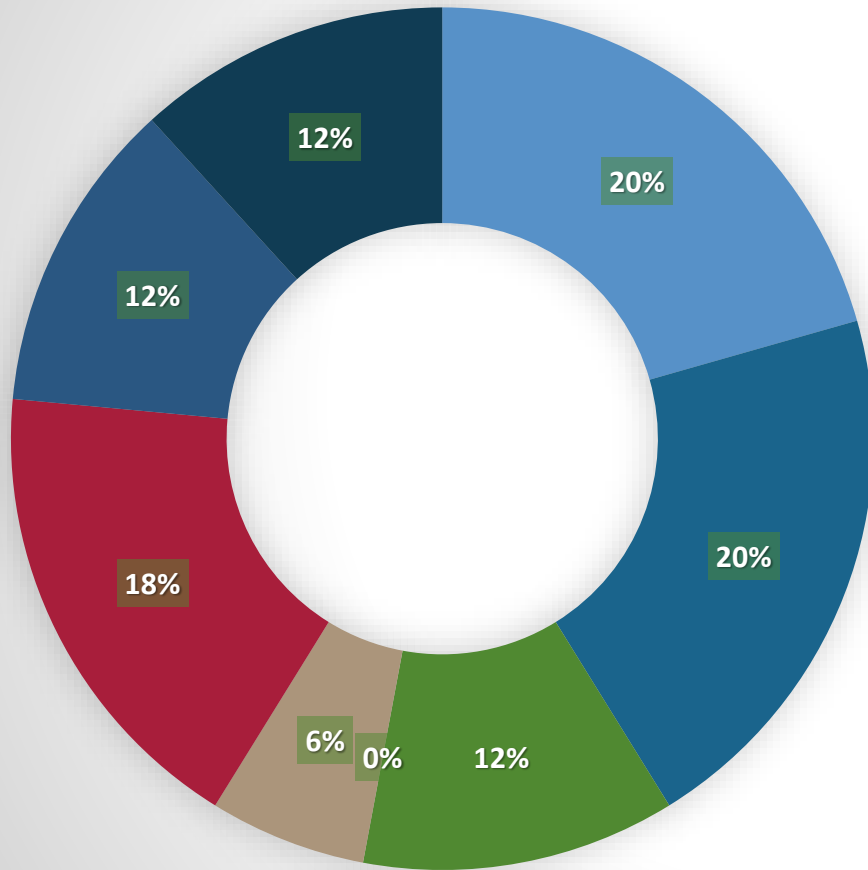
