Info sheet

(Please read this note carefully and keep a copy for your trip)

1) Air tickets

All of the participants are responsible for their own travel expenses.

The International Airport Ezeiza, also known as Ministro Pistarini Airport, is situated in the province of Buenos Aires, some 35 km from the city centre and 28.62 km from the event venue (Salón Salguero Plaza). Among the available transport options, you can choose from official taxis and remises, ride-hailing apps (Uber, Cabify and similar services), private transfer services, and urban public transport.

2) Registration for the CAMEVET Seminar

Registration is mandatory for all the participants.

3) Inscription fee

The fee is 250 US Dollars, to be paid **in cash** at the beginning of the meeting.

Registration is free of charge for the Nacional Focal Points and accredited Veterinary Services staff.

4) Visas for entry into Argentina

All participants are responsible for finding out about any visas and/or transit visas required and for making the necessary arrangements to obtain them for the outward and return journeys.

It is recommended that you travel to Argentina with a valid passport. If you do not have a valid passport, please visit the website of the [National Directorate of Migration](#), where you will find a list of countries whose citizens require a visa to enter, as well as other requirements.

Participants are advised to contact the Argentine Embassy or Consulate in their country to complete the necessary formalities. In countries where Argentina does not have diplomatic representation, visas can be obtained from the nearest embassy or consulate.

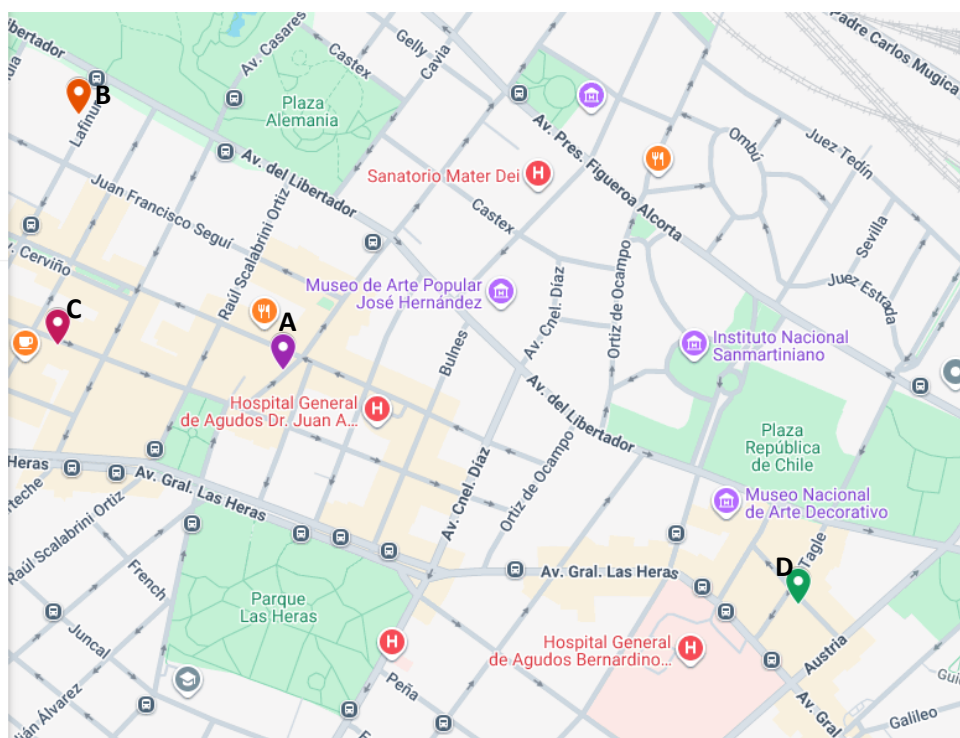
